The Friends of St. Mary's was formed in 1979 to support the restoration and repair of the Parish Church of St. Mary the Virgin and of Church House in Long Crendon.

The church dates from the 12th century and is a magnificent example of cruciform design. It stands in a commanding position at the eastern end of the High Street beside the 15th century Court House. For many people in Long Crendon the church is more than a place of worship for the Anglican community, it is also a focal point in the life of the whole village as is evident each year with a performance of the Medieval Plays.
